

INFORMATION REGARDING THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA PURSUANT TO REGULATION (EU) 2016/679

3. Delivery method of the seminar

The seminar is delivered on the Microsoft Teams platform. To participate, it is not mandatory to activate your own webcam and microphone.

The data collected through the aforementioned platform are processed and used exclusively to allow the Seminar to take place and/or to give evidence of its effective execution and participation. During these activities, exchanges of images and audio are useful and sometimes necessary to allow the Seminar to take place, however we inform you that:

- in the case of webcam and/or microphone activation, they can be seen and heard by any other participant.
- the seminar is recorded, you can oppose the recording by deactivating the audio and/or video

AUTHORIZATION TO USE IMAGES AND AUDIO

The interested party also accepts the following specification for which he grants the use of images and audio free of charge, also pursuant to articles 10 and 320 of the civil code . and of the articles 96 and 97 Law 22.4.1941, n. 633, Law on copyright, to the publication and/or diffusion in any form of one's own images for the purposes indicated above.

Therefore, by voluntarily activating the audio and/or video, you explicitly consent to the processing of your data and authorize the conservation of the recordings in the institution's computer archives and acknowledges that the purpose of such conservation is merely of a historical archiving nature and they can never be transferred for different purposes. The authorization can be withdrawn at any time, as required by regulation 679/16, and the organization will not use the images further. In any case, these limitations will only be possible on the data still held by the organization.

CGPT will submit you a customer questionnaire satisfaction to be filled in anonymously, to assess your satisfaction with the service offered .

Your personal data will be processed with manual and IT tools using appropriate technical and organizational security measures, pursuant to Article 32 of the GDPR and in compliance with the new Legislative Decree 196/03 , in order to guarantee the security, integrity and the confidentiality of the data itself.

4. Purposes and legal bases of the treatment

Your personal data will be processed exclusively to allow you to register and participate in the Seminar, as well as to forward you , if necessary, a copy of the seminar documents, any supplementary documentation in relation to the contents, as well as any certificate of participation (where provided the list of participants in the Seminar will be kept by the CPGT for reporting purposes).

The legal basis of the processing consists of the execution of contractual and/or pre-contractual measures in reference to participation in the Seminar (art. 6, paragraph 1, letter b of EU Reg. 2016/679), legal obligations ((art. 6 , paragraph 1, letter c of EU Regulation 2016/679), explicit consent for video images and the use of audio (art 6. paragraph 1 letter a of EU Regulation 2016/679)

5. Authorized persons, Data Processors and Recipients of personal data

Your data will be shared with the speakers for the purposes referred to in point 4 of this information. Furthermore, the list of participants may be shared with government bodies of the European Community for the purposes of compliance with legal obligations and community agreements.

The data may also be processed by external subjects, formally appointed by the Data Controller as Data Processors and belonging to the following categories:

- Companies that provide management and maintenance services for the organisation's information systems;
- Companies that provide telematic communications services and, in particular, e-mail;
- Any suppliers who perform services for the pursuit of the purposes referred to in this information;

6. Data retention period

Personal data will be stored CPGT within a maximum period of 10 years from the conclusion of the Seminar, for the purposes indicated in point 4 of this information.

7. Nature of the provision of data and consequences of any failure to provide it

The conferment of your data and the related treatment is mandatory to allow you to participate in the seminar, your refusal or partial/inaccurate conferment may jeopardize your participation in the initiative. On the other hand, the provision is optional for the acquisition and publication of video and audio images. As indicated in point 3, turning on the webcam and microphone during the meeting remains entirely optional.

8. Transfer of data to non-EU countries

The CPGT may avail itself, also through its Data Processors, of IT service and telematic communications companies and, in particular, of webconference telematic platforms, which could place or transit the data even in countries not belonging to the Economic European. These Companies can implement the transfer only to countries (or sectors thereof) that have been the subject of specific adequacy decisions adopted by the European Commission, or on the basis of Standard Contractual Clauses approved by the European Commission.

9. Rights of the interested party

The Regulation (EU) 2016/679 recognizes you, as an interested party, various rights, which you can exercise by contacting the Data Controller or the DPO at the addresses referred to in points 1 and 2 of this information.

Among the exercisable rights, provided that the conditions provided from time to time by the legislation are met (in particular, articles 15 and following of EU Reg. 2016/679) there are: the right to know if CPGT is processing personal data that concern you and, in this case, to have access to the data being processed and to all the information relating to it; the right to rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning you and/or to the integration of incomplete ones; the right to have your personal data deleted; the right to limitation of treatment; the right to object to the processing; the right to the portability of personal data concerning you, if applicable to the case.
